There are 9 domains in Health Science: Foundations of Health Education (Domain 1), Human Growth and Development domain (2), Chronic and Communicable Diseases (3), Nutrition and Fitness (4), Mental and Emotional Health (5), Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs (6), Family Life and Interpersonal Relationships (7), Consumer and Community Health (8), Environmental Health (9). The CSET groups the domains as follows: Subtest I: Foundations of Health Education; Human Growth and Development; Chronic and Communicable Disease (Domains 1, 2, and 3). Subtest II: Nutrition and Fitness; Mental and Emotional Health; Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs (Domains 4,5, and 6). Subtest III: Family Life and Interpersonal Relationships; Consumer and Community Health; Environmental Health (Domains 7, 8, and 9). This table is used to determine domains where candidates meet subject matter vis coursework.
