# WHAT IS THIS PROGRAM ABOUT?

## Share your culture with Long Beach youth

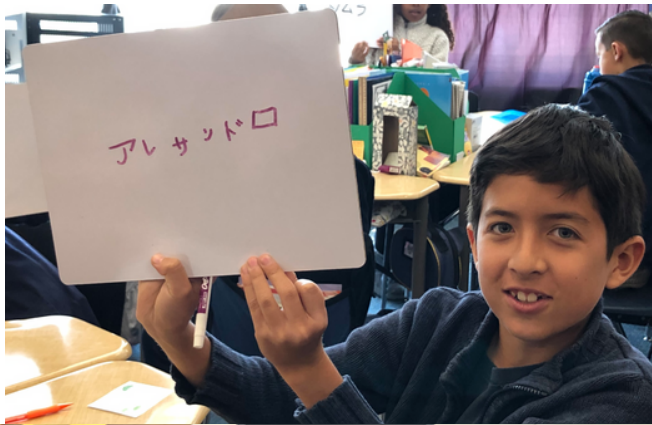
Intercultural Diplomats is a cross-cultural exchange program for K-12 classrooms in the Long Beach community. Diplomats will give lessons that encourage global competence, and appreciation of other cultures and create a positive relationship between members of different cultures. Diplomats will develop global competency and leadership skills while also forming positive relationships with persons from multiple diverse American backgrounds.

## Program Requirements

This program is made up of 2 training workshops to learn how to effectively teach global competency techniques, acquire leadership skills, and create lesson plans with teachers, followed by 2-3 visits to the classroom to implement those lessons. Lessons will occur between February and April. A small stipend of \$400 will be offered to those who complete all elements of this program.

## Eligibility

- Must be an international degree student or exchange student enrolled in the spring 2024 term.
- Must be in good standing (undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or above, graduate GPA of 3.0 or above) and not on academic probation.
- All majors are encouraged to apply!



## Program Timeline

- Applications Open: October 1
- Application Deadline: November 1
- Candidate Interviews: November 17th & 18th
- Candidate Welcome & Orientation: December 9
- Meet your Host Teacher: January 27
- Classroom Teaching: February - April
- Closing Ceremony: April 26
