Program Requirements

The minor in Equity and Education Studies requires fifteen units

Two three-unit introductory courses are required for all students in the program:

- L/ST 310: Educational Equity & Justice
- L/ST 320: Intersectionality in Education

Then students select
one of the field work
courses from their
chosen or potential
pathway (Multiple
subject; Single Subject;
or Education Specialist)
all of which require field
work in schools

Students then select six units of special topics courses from existing courses in the university that touch on educational topics
