Dear,

To help ensure your safety and those around you, all residential students are required to be tested for **COVID-19.** To facilitate this, the university has arranged for testing tomorrow, Monday, September 28. The testing site will be in Parking Lot G1 (the lot adjacent to International House and across from Student Health Services). See the attached map.

All residential students are mandated to be tested or provide evidence of a test taken within the last three days. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in removal from housing, student conduct action, and possible other actions. This is a requirement from public health officials and we, as a campus community, must comply.

There is no need for an appointment. The City will be taking role based upon a housing roster. Residential students are being scheduled alphabetical by last names. **Your designated testing time is between x-x p.m.** This is only for residential students.

If you have been tested within the past 3 days, you will not need to be retested but will instead need to bring confirmation of a test to the testing tent. Whether tested on campus or at an off-campus site, you will need to communicate your results to the case management team at SHS. They should have already communicated with you.

Reminder: you should be wearing a mask and maintaining social distance when reporting to Lot G1 for testing.
