Line 119 amendment, "assigned by instructor or designee" PS amendment, remove "or designee" moved and seconded. JC friendly amendment accepted "if the instructor is unavailable, the chair or program director can serve as designee" Vote on amendment, yes=37 no=11 amendment passes. Lines 127-130 no amendments, lines 132-137 no amendments, line 138 DP amendment, add "except in the case of graduate or honor's theses and projects" moved and seconded. Vote on amendment, yes=44 no=0 amendment passes unanimously. Line 143 NH amendment, replace text with "please see the Policy on Withdrawals for complete information. Vote on amendment, passed with unanimous consent. Line 152, MA amendment, moved and seconded. Replace section 3.1 with new language. Ending at line 152.
