7. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 7.1 Proposed revision of PS 19-08, Policy on General Education (AS-1137-20/CEPC)-SECOND READING
 - (Resuming Line 312, Section 3.2.3.1) amended by J. Pandya, moved and seconded. Add language "US History courses... fulfill their Area D requirements (double-count)." Discussion of amendment ensues.
 - After a 50-minute discussion, N. Schürer "calls the question" to close debate, moved and seconded. Vote on ending discussion, and two-thirds in favor (voting results: Yes=51, No= 11).
 - $\circ\quad$ End debate and vote on the amendment.
 - Voting Results: Yes=25, No=34. Amendment Fails.
 - Line 351-355, Section 3.2.4.1. amended by E. MacDonald, moved and seconded.
 Add language "Students must complete ... and one course in D-UD, Social Science." Discussion of amendment ensues.
 - After a 15-minute discussion, A. Colburn "calls the question" to close debate, moved and seconded. Vote on ending discussion, and two-thirds in favor (voting results: Yes=38, No= 19).
 - End debate and vote on the amendment.

Voting Results: Yes=33, No=23. Amendment *Passes*.

End at this point. Will resume at this line (Line 355) at next AS meeting.
