 - 6.1 Report from CSULB President Jane Conoley: TIME CERTAIN 2:10 PM
 - Repopulation efforts. All Spring 21 courses start virtually on 1/19/21. Plan on resuming the approved FTF courses after 2/01 or 2/08/21.
 - JC suggested not traveling. If travel is necessary, plan on self-quarantine for 14 days.

- Another CSU campus was targeted by ransomware with a quarter milliondollar ransom. Our VP Dr. Min Yao is working on updating security systems.
- CSULB will be offering COVID testing in Spring for those working on campus.
- JC encourages everyone to share ideas on how to help students who affect by the pandemic to continue their education
- CSU Chancellor White will have a live-streamed conversation with Dr. Anthony Fauci on 12/18/20. The virtual event will also include a Q&A session between Dr. Fauci and CSU campus presidents. More information is forthcoming.

 - Line 146 amended by A. Colburn, moved and seconded. Add language "this clause shall not apply to students... ultimately held not responsible... cheating or plagiarism."
 - Voting Results: Yes=26, No=32. Amendment *Fails*.
 - Vote on the entire policy, moved and seconded. Voting Results: Yes=50, No=4. **Policy Passes.**
 - 7.3 Proposed Revision of PS 17-18, Employment of Graduate Students as Student Assistants, Instructional Student Assistants, Graduate Assistants, and Teaching Associates (AS-1100-19/FPPC)—SECOND READING
 - (Resume on) Line 130, amended by M. Aliasgari, moved and seconded. Add language "Doctoral students at CSULB...coursework." Voting Results: Yes=28, No=22. Amendment **Passes**.

- Line 126, amended by C. Bennett, moved and seconded. Move this section to below (Line 141). *Approved by acclamation*.
- Line 191, amended by P. Shankar, moved and seconded. Delete the word *"department"* and replace the word *"develop"* with *"make available."* Voting Results: Yes=41 No=11. Amendment *Passes*.
- Vote on the entire policy, moved and seconded. Voting Results: Yes=49, No=3. **Policy Passes.**
