Liberal Studies provides a rich cross-disciplinary liberal arts program of study for the **field of Education**. There are two primary program pathways within the program that students must select from for graduation.

BA Pathway

The BA pathway is the traditional teacher education program where students complete their **Bachelor of Arts degree in Liberal Studies**. After completion of the B.A, they may continue their education as a post-bac student and complete a teaching credential at CSULB or at another university.

ITEP Pathway

The Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP) combines the study of academic subject matter for elementary school teaching with professional preparation & student teaching. Completion of ITEP includes both a **Bachelor of Arts degree in Liberal Studies** <u>and</u> **Teaching Credential(s)**.
