### **Declaring the Minor**

- : Submit Minor Application
- : Meet with School of Art advisors to approve minor
- : Min. GPA 3.0 in major, 2.00 GPA overall
- : Completed lower division courses in minor with a GPA of 3.0

#### **Minor Requirements:**

√Not available to BFA Option in Photography majors

√Must maintain 3.0 GPA in minor

√Must be completed within major degree completion

 $\sqrt{9}$  units of coursework must be distinct to the minor,

and cannot be double-counted for the major

With consultation from the College of the Arts enrollment manager, space available for minors will be determined on an annual basis. If more applications are received than there is space available, applications will be ranked by a weighted average of student GPAs and a faculty revie of statements of intent. Students will be admitted into available spaces according to these rankings.
