NOTE: This checklist is not intended to replace advising from the major department. Students should consult with the major advisor to determine the appropriate sequence of courses. This checklist is to inform students of major requirements and course prerequisites only; the [CSULB Course Catalog](#) takes precedence in any conflict. CSULB Enrollment Services prepares the Academic Requirements Report, which is the official graduation verification.

Before adding any minors, students must check to see if this addition will affect CSULB's [Timely Graduation for Undergraduate Students](#) policy. Under this policy, students may earn up to 120% of the number of units required for the degree in their **declared primary major**. In addition, the policy requires that a student must file a Request to Graduate form with Enrollment Services by the time the student has completed 100% of the units required for the declared primary major. Any additional degree objectives (e.g., majors, minors, certificates, etc.) must be completed within the 120% unit limit.

The 20-unit minor in Geology is available to any non-Geology major.
