- III. Approval of Minutes GEGC Meeting April 25, 2022 posted in BeachBoard

 - b. Passed with 9 "yes" votes; 0 "no" votes; 4 abstain votes
- IV. Review of New Courses (posted in BeachBoard Course Proposals New Courses)
 - a. GEOG_PSY_175 Requesting area E Received 2022_05_19
 - i. Overall Comments
 - 1. Needs to highlight connections between policy and information literacy
 - ii. Justification
 - 1. Does a good job of addressing Area E
 - 2. Needs clearer statement(s) about what exact lifelong learning skills students will get from course, e.g., clarify connection to skill like information literacy; unpack how neighborhood literacy is a skill and how it relates to wellness
 - iii. Measurable SLOs
 - 1. Phrasing and SLO/GELO connections need revision. Examples:
 - a. SLO 2 not matching with GELO E1; SLO 2 may match with E2
 - b. SLO 3 not matching with GELO E2
 - c. SLO 4 where is the critical thinking?
 - d. Why is learning these things important to the self, in relation to Life Long Learning? What is self-development? Area E needs to be more clearly connected
 - iv. Course Assessments
 - 1. Assessments will need matching changes to the SLO/GELO edits
 - v. <u>Recommendation</u>: GEOG/PSY175 Approve after changes to the Justification and the SLOs.

- 1. Passed with 15 "yes" votes; 0 "no" votes; 0 abstain votes
- b. RGR_360 Requesting UD-D Received 2022_05_23
 - i. Justification
 - 1. Justification of "espionage studies" (which does not seem to be an existing title of a field of study)
 - a. Suggest: "Studies about espionage" or similar style of rephrasing
 - ii. Measurable SLOs
 - 1. SLO 2 methodologies AND theories (related to GELO 2)
 - iii. Course Assessments
 - 1. There is no 4, there is only a and b
 - iv. Outline of subject matter by week
 - 1. Some weeks do not mention theories in weeks tagged with GELO 2
 - a. Some weeks clearly highlight methodologies/theories, some do not.
 - i. Perhaps GELO 2 not needed on so many weeks only needed when methodologies/theories are explicitly noted.
 - 1. <u>Example</u>: Week 6 does not seem to have any theory.
 - 2. <u>Reminder</u>: Only need 1/3 of the weeks to be GELO-related.
 - v. Recommendation: Approve RGR 360 after changes/return to Exec.
