Self-Guided Tour Guidelines

If this is for a group, we recommend the size be limited to 100 students per tour.

Students

- Students must respect CSULB property.
- Students must remain with chaperones throughout the duration of the tour.
- Students should not interrupt or interfere with normal campus activities.

Chaperones

- Must provide one chaperone for every 10 students. Larger groups may be split into subgroups.
- If you choose to eat on campus, lunch will not be provided by CSULB.
- The supervision of students will be your responsibility.

Parking Information

- For cars park in a General Lot. *Virtual parking permits are required to park on campus*. For additional parking information, stop by the Visitor Information Center located on <u>Beach Drive</u> between Earl Warren Drive and Merriam Way.
- For busses park in Lot G9 and G13. School busses with state license plates can park at no charge, but all other busses such as charter busses will need to purchase a permit from the dispenser. The bus parking rate is \$75. The driver of the bus can also choose to find parking off campus.
- The drop off and pick up location for buses is located at the east turnaround.

• Visiting students must follow the University Student Union (USU) Guidelines in the following areas: arcade, bowling, pool and billiards.
