We are pleased to be one of the first to congratulate and **confirm your spot** in housing at the California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) Housing and Residential Life. Welcome to *"The Beach!"* We are glad to have you as a member of our Residence Hall community. While living at *The Beach*, will be different from previous years, we do hope to make you feel as a part of a great community.

As you know we have been working with the county and Long Beach Public Health Department as well as our own campus health leadership to determine what we can offer for students in the spring. Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic, we have had to severely restrict our capacity to only permit students who meet a very high need for housing. Based upon our conversations with health officials, we feel confident in the ability to welcome you to campus. We have been cautioned that all decisions are still contingent on the ever-changing Covid-19 situation in our area.

Part of this planning is putting student individually into rooms with no roommates for Spring term, at the Double room rate. Due to the nature of this plan, the Housing Office will assign you to a room. You will not be choosing a roommate or room for the term.

Provost Jersky has notified campus that in-person classes are going to be delayed. This means our move-in day will also be delayed. Please continue to watch your email, especially in early January, we hope to provide you updated information about when you can move into your residence hall room.

Please note that congregate living like residence halls pose an increased risk to spread the virus. If for some reason, your situation changes before you move in and you would no longer need housing, we will release you from your contract without penalty. To change your plans and cancel your housing placement, simply log back on to your housing application and cancel. Once you enter the application process, the cancel button is located on the top right-hand corner of the page.
