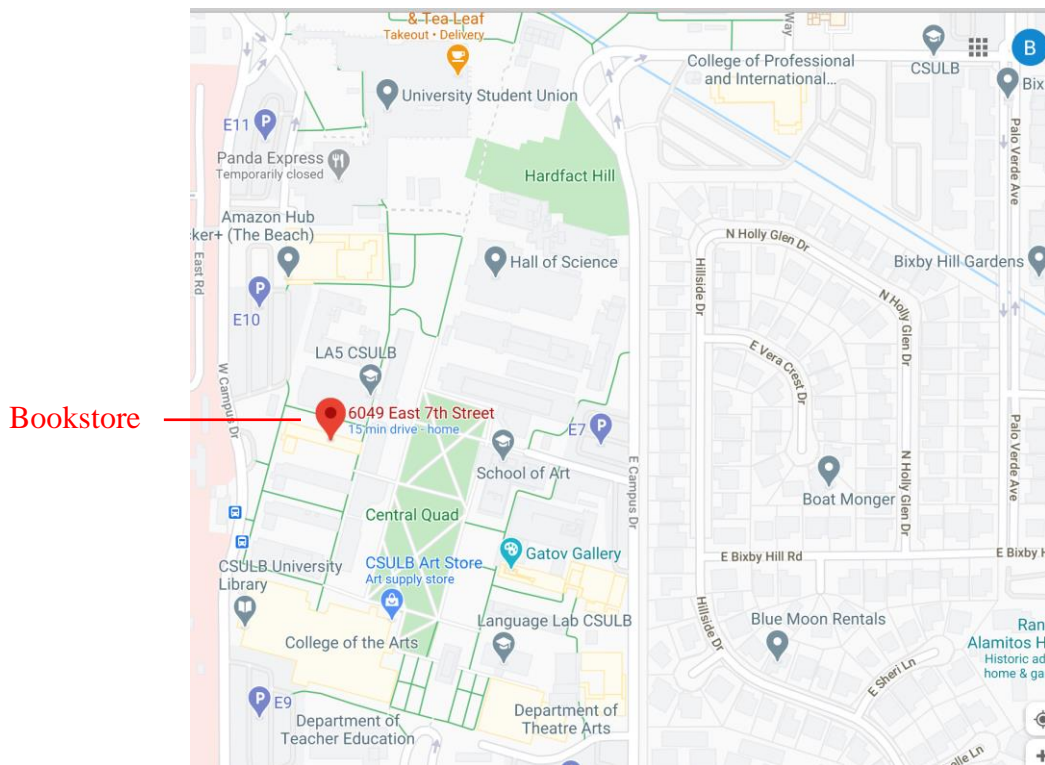

### Benefits of a CSULB ID Card

Once an OLLI Member registers his/her ID card at the front desk of the [CSULB library](#), he/she has full library privileges.

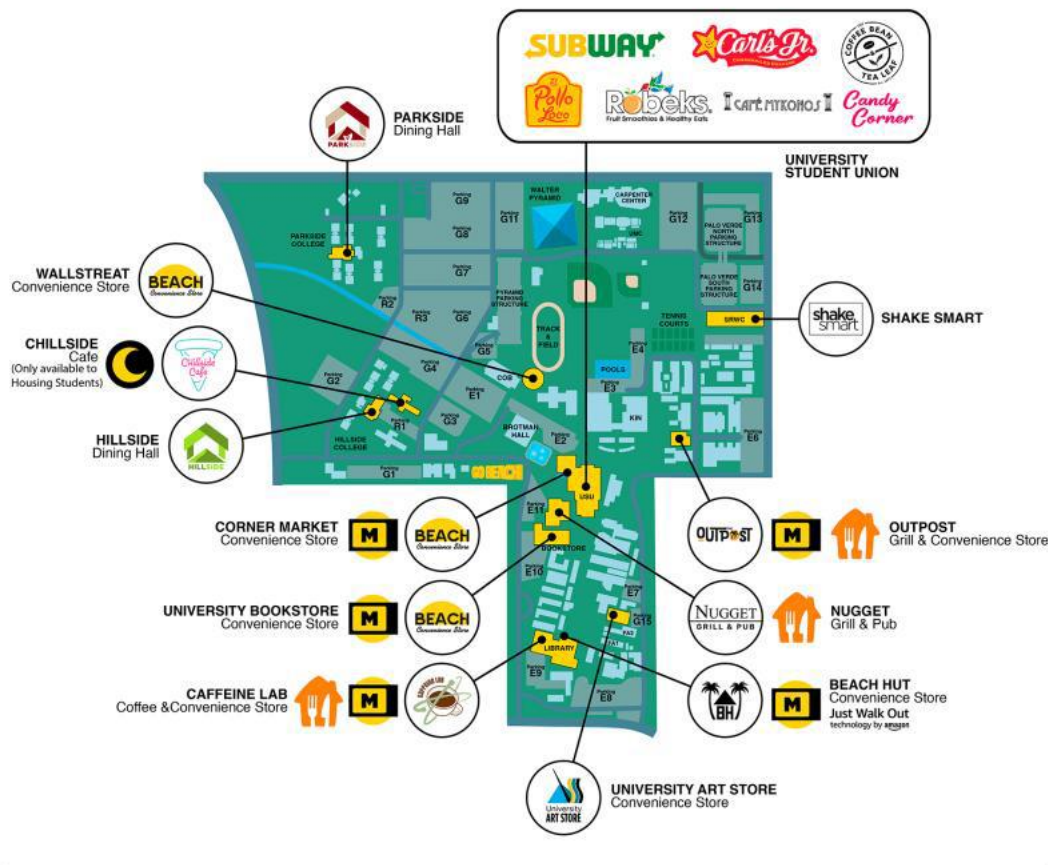
**University Dining Plaza (next to University Bookstore):** Nugget Grill & Pub

## LifeFit Center

### **Information**

The LifeFit Center @ The Beach is an experiential learning and research laboratory within the department of kinesiology.

To provide students with learning and research opportunities, LifeFit serves as a health and fitness facility to all CSULB faculty and staff and to community members age 49+.

### **Location**

- The LifeFit Center @ The Beach is located in the Kinesiology Building (northeast corner). Please use Deukmejian Way to access Parking Lot E4.

### **Pricing**

- Community Rate - \$35 monthly
- OLLI Member - \$25 monthly
- Alumni Association/Legacy Society Members - \$25 monthly
- Silver Sneakers – Free. LifeFit will need your 16-digit SilverSneakers membership number to begin your membership.
- Parking is a separate fee. Members must obtain a Parking Request Form from the LifeFit Service Desk in order to purchase parking at Brotman Hall.
- Only LifeFit members who are not employees of CSULB are eligible to purchase monthly parking through the LifeFit Center.

## Campus Parking Information

### **How To Get a Campus Parking Permit**

### Cost

- OLLI participants can purchase CSULB Community Parking Permits for \$57 per calendar month or an Activity Parking Permit (after 4 p.m.) for \$37 per calendar month.
- Parking Permits may be used in Lots G13, G14 off Palo Verde Avenue south of Atherton Road or any other General Lot on Campus.
- Community Parking Permits are valid in many lots on Campus (see maps) as well as Employee Lots after 5:30 p.m. and all day on weekends.

### Foundation Lot

- Beginning in October 2024, OLLI members can purchase two month permits for the Foundation Lot for \$114.
- The Foundation Lot is the closest parking lot to OLLI with a large number of parking spaces.
- Contact the OLLI Office at to apply for a Foundation Lot permit.

## OLLI – CSULB Good-To-Know

### Things to Know About Parking

- Receipts are not issued for any permit purchased at a kiosk. The final message will be “Transaction – Virtual Permit”
- OLLI students possessing a California DMV-issued Disabled Parking Permit and a Community Parking Permit may park in an ADA spot in Lot E6.
- OLLI students cannot park in an Employee Only or restricted space.

### Campus Shuttle Information

- Campus shuttles are provided by Parking & Transportation Services as a free service to all students, staff, and faculty. Please show your campus ID card to the driver to board a campus shuttle. Shuttles do not operate on days when classes are not in session including fall break, spring break, winter break, and holidays.
- Full schedule hours and route info is listed below as well as on the [PassioGO](#) app.
- Shuttle arrival times are approximations based on averages. Similar to city bus operations, these times may fluctuate based on the amount of vehicles on campus, rain/other inclement weather, and ridership volume as additional time is needed to board large numbers of students or individuals requiring accessibility assistance.

### Long Beach Transit Senior Tap Card Information

- Long Beach Transit (LBT) offers a reduced fare TAP card program for seniors who are 62 years or older. The program provides the following benefits:
  - Single ride: \$0.60 for a single ride
  - Day pass: \$2.50 for a day pass
  - 5-day pass: \$9 for a 5-day pass
  - 30-day pass: \$24 for a 30-day pass
- Seniors can apply for a TAP card online, by mail, or in person:
  - Online: Visit [taptogo.net](http://taptogo.net)
  - In person: Visit the Transit & Visitor Information Center at 130 E. First Street, Long Beach, CA 90802
  - By mail: Download the form and mail it to TAP Reduced Fare Office, One Gateway Plaza, Mail Stop 99-PL-4, Los Angeles, CA 90012-2952
- Applicants who apply in person will receive a temporary TAP card to use until their permanent card arrives. Applicants who apply by mail will receive their TAP card within 20 business days after verification.

### Other Transportation Options

#### Uber

Get a taxi, private car or rideshare from your mobile phone. Uber connects you with a driver in minutes. Use our app in cities around the world.

#### Lyft

Rideshare with Lyft. Lyft is your friend with a car, whenever you need one. Download the app, and get a ride from a friendly driver within minutes.

NOTE: Both Ridesharing plans use a credit card and Smart phone App to use.

#### Access

- For those who have certain disabilities and are unable to use the fixed route bus system, the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) provides for complementary paratransit services. These services are provided by Access Services, Inc. To receive an application, call 1-800-827-0829 (TDD 1-800-827-1359).
- Access Services is the county-wide complementary paratransit service which is required under the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). This agency provides mobility for those persons who are not capable of using regular fixed route transit service in Los Angeles County, including Long Beach Transit's service area. Representatives of the fixed route transit systems in Los Angeles County sit on the ASI Board of Directors.
- To be served by ASI, a person must become certified as eligible. Eligibility is determined by ASI based on several components which include an application, interview, and a mobility evaluation. For more information, contact ASI at (213) 270-6000 or [www.asila.org](http://www.asila.org).

#### Dial-A-Lift

Long Beach Dial-A-Lift is a local paratransit program for residents of Long Beach, Lakewood and Signal Hill. Members of Dial-A-Lift must be 18 years of age or older, have a permanent mobility impairment that does not allow them use of the Long Beach Transit fixed-route bus system. You may apply for Long Beach Dial-A-Lift membership by calling Long Beach Dial-A-Lift at 562-591-8753
