
Dance at the Beach





- The Dance Center at CSULB boasts seven spacious dance studios. Each studio is equipped with ballet bars, advanced audio and video capabilities, and tons of natural light. We have both Marley Dance Flooring and hardwood to allow forms like Hip-Hop and Tap which require shoes.
- Studio 3 is equipped with LED Stage Lighting and multiple cameras for streaming of informal performances. This space also includes white sound panels that are appropriate for projection work. Studio 3's Performance Space is ideal for students and faculty presenting works in progress or hosting informal dance concerts.
- While Studio 7 offers both a classroom and studio space for classes that are equal parts lecture and movement, the Dance Center also has a traditional Smart Classroom for lecture only classes.
- A Pilates Lab where students can exercise and learn about the body.
- An iMac computer lab with video, photo, and sound editing equipment for student lab hours and computer based lessons.
- The Martha B. Knoebel Dance Theater is a dedicated dance stage with a capacity of 230 seats and a large stage perfect for dance.

Audition Information

The application to apply for first-time/first-year and transfer students opens on October 1st and closes on November 30th for Fall admission. Please apply via Cal State Apply.

Once you have submitted your application to the University, please email dance@csulb.edu and request our additional Audition Application. Once you fill out your Audition Application, you will receive a confirmation within one business day from our audition coordinator confirming your audition date and time, providing directions and further audition instructions and expectations.

Auditions will be held for First-Time, First-Year students in late February/early March.

Auditions consist of two technique classes of the student's choice in the following forms: jazz, modern/contemporary, hip-hop/street dance,

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN DANCE




BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS IN DANCE

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance is designed to prepare students for professional careers as performers and/or choreographers. Students wishing to pursue the BFA in Dance must demonstrate strong technical ability and must audition for the BFA program after successfully completing the following course work with a minimum GPA of 3.0

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN DANCE SCIENCE

The Bachelor of Science in Dance Science provides students with an interdisciplinary course of study that helps to prepare them for graduate study and careers in dance, dance science, physical therapy, athletic training, or occupational therapy, careers in fitness and somatics, and/or graduate education in the areas of dance science, dance medicine, exercise science, or related dance studies. Students interested in the B.S. in Dance Science should meet with the Program Coordinator no later than the start of their 2nd year (earlier for transfer students).
