WHAT: The School of Social Work at California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) is holding an Information/Recruitment Meeting for prospective Masters of Social Work (MSW) students in Sonoma and Ventura counties and surrounding counties. The meeting will focus on the Distance Education program, the admissions process, and student internships organized through Practicum Education.

WHY: To hear more about our next 3-year MSW program. Pending finalization of funding and continued student interest, our new cohort is expected to begin in the fall of 2025.

Admission applications will be accepted from October 1, 2024 - January 15, 2025.

All classes are held on Saturdays and most are delivered in real-time onsite and in-person via teleconferencing with frequent in-person visits by faculty. During the second and third academic years of the program, a 16-hour per week practicum education internship placement is required and arranged locally. Stipends are available for public child welfare employees.
