President Conoley's Fellowship Program is an initiative of the Beach Pluralism Project which aims to foster an inclusive, compassionate, and socially equitable society. Selected Conoley Fellows will receive training in the theory and practice of pluralism. Students in the program will take two courses over two semesters, attend extracurricular activities and receive a stipend of \$5000. All undergraduates are welcome to apply, no pre-requisites are needed.

What this Fellowship Offers

- ★ A \$5,000 stipend, paid as Financial Aid
- ★ Be a part of a learning community
- ★ Attend extracurricular activities, such as monthly fellowship dinners
- ★ Gain experience in leadership, conflict resolution, peacemaking, interfaith competencies and implementing pluralism
- ★ Develop communication and negotiating skills needed to counteract social divisiveness and polarization
- ★ Get the tools to generate a lasting positive impact on communities and on our greater social landscape
