- The purpose of the URC is to review changes that could have a financial impact to the university. Campus staff bring items to the Committee and we review/approve them before they go to Academic Senate for final approval.

 - Proposed changes in degree programs, names of programs, (see item 3 & 4 on slide #17).

- Recent meeting: made recommendations for strategies to improve enrollment on campus, including:
 - Implementing a client relationship management (CRM) system for comms with students; in order to have targeted comms with more granularity to find prospective student based on demographics, interests, etc. the CRM would also help to coordinate comms from multiple campus units; will help to predict which students will likely apply to CSULB and commit.
 - Improving comms and web presence for prospective students
 - Finding ways to enhance enrollment in under-enrolled programs;
 identifying undeclared students to guide them in these directions.

- President Conoley-- Do you have any questions about the protests on campus?
 - Only a couple of times when we felt uneasy-- e.g. students were using furniture for barricades at Fountain and when students wanted to occupy the Pyramid.
 - I feel great about much of how the student protesters conducted themselves they cleaned up afterwards and didn't damage anything—compared to other campuses around the country.
 - Having an emergency meeting tonight about the issue / demand of looking at investments/divestments re: socially responsible funds to make sure we are aligned; we are working 24/7 to protect students' rights to free speech; btw, yesterday a nice event on campus where dissenting groups were tabling near each other but there was no conflict.
 - Student Affairs is doing a good job educating students about Time, Place policies related to organizing demonstrations.
