

The TRiO McNair Scholars Program is a federally-funded program designed to prepare and support underrepresented undergraduate students in their pursuit of doctoral studies.

Program Eligibility

To be considered for the TRiO McNair Scholars Program at California State University Long Beach (CSULB), you must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. A U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- 2. Currently enrolled at CSULB as undergraduate with at least 3.00 cum GPA.
- 3. Completed at least 60 units (transfer units included) by end of current academic year. You must have at least 2 semesters (Spring, Summer and Fall) or more left before graduation.
- 4. Must be considered:
 - a. <u>Both</u> low-income based on federal income guidelines <u>and</u> first-generation status (parent/guardian did not earn a 4-year college degree); OR
 - b. Member of an underrepresented minority group (e.g. *Black/African American non-Hispanic; Hispanic/Latino, American Indian/Alaska Native, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander*).
- 5. Must be available to do research Summer 2024
- 6. Intention to pursue and complete a Ph.D.

How to Apply

If you meet the eligibility requirements listed above, you are encouraged to apply!

- 1. Complete all components of the TRIO McNair Scholars Program Application (e.g., student information, dependency status, self-assessment, degree plan, essay questions and appropriate signatures).
- 2. Attach a copy of your most current *unofficial* CSULB transcript (accessed via MyCSULB).
- 3. Sign and submit the completed TRIO McNair Scholars Program Application and supplemental documents as a <u>PDF file</u> to <u>mcnair@csulb.edu</u>. If you need assistance creating a PDF file, please email <u>mcnair@csulb.edu</u>.
- 4. Submit your completed application by indicated deadline on the website.
