 - c. As discussed in the policy document, the larger group will be split into the committee (3 4 groups) to do the review. At least 1 reviewer comes from the college of the applicant. Each group will have 7 8 applications, and they will be scored from 1 4. Small committees do not need to have a chair, but they should appoint a group leader. Committees suggest that if there is a difference of more

than 2 points then the small review group should meet to discuss. If not, they can submit the score to the chair. It will then be reviewed by chair and co-chairs.
