In recognition of outstanding baccalaureate student achievements

With the approval of the dean of the college, departments may elect to award departmental honors to their baccalaureate graduates based on G.P.A. and/or other criteria determined by the department. Departmental honors are usually reserved for students whose outstanding performance is not otherwise recognized by university or college awards. The number of honors awarded by a department shall be limited to three students or five percent of graduates, whichever is larger.

Baccalaureate graduates are eligible for departmental honors if they have completed all bachelor's degree requirements and are receiving a diploma dated December 2024, January 2025, May 2025, August 2025, or December 2025.

Deadlines

- Nominations of graduates due to department offices: Monday, February 17, 2025.
- Department recommendations for honors due to CNSM College Office: Monday, March 3, 2025.

Criteria

- Nominees must complete all degree requirements and be receiving a diploma dated December 2024, January 2025, May 2025, August 2025, or December 2025.
- Nominees must have graduated (December 2024) or filed for graduation (Deadline: March 1, 2025 for on-time Fall 2025; late filing for Spring/Summer 2025 with \$10 fee).
- Departments may have additional requirements.
