Criteria

- Nominees must complete all degree requirements and be receiving a diploma dated December 2024, January 2025, May 2025, August 2025, or December 2025.
- Nominees must have filed for graduation (Deadline: March 1, 2025 for on-time Fall 2025; late filing for Spring/Summer 2025 with \$10 fee).
- Any additional Department requirements for demonstrating excellence, involvement, and dedication at CSULB during nominee's undergraduate career.
