A Note From Our Artistic Director

Welcome to Cal Rep's Spring Season. We launch this semester with *Dreamers: Aquí y Allá*. This world premiere is a devised, verbatim theatre piece about the "Dreamers": the more than 800,000 immigrants who were brought to the U.S. as children and able to work or study here through the DACA Program (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals). With the future of DACA threatened, this has become a national drama and a very local one too: over 200,000 Dreamers are in California and there are 900 DACA students on our CSULB campus. This piece, created in collaboration with the California-Mexico Studies Center, weaves together interviews with DACA students on campus – along with verbatim text from politicians and lawyers who were interviewed during the process and the actors' own original text – to create an epic story of heroic struggles: of battling a culture of fear, fighting for one's family, searching for one's identity and pursuing the American Dream. This is exactly the kind of theatre I want Cal Rep to produce: urgent, timely, essential and theatre that cultivates dialogue and provides a call to action.
